### Footnotes

SAINT VERRE quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, drew away turning for home and was kept to a drive to the wire. WINDSOR CASTLE raced close up early, advanced inside on the turn and rallied to earn the place prize. JUDGE'S CASE was unhurried early on, raced inside and lacked a rally. PUZZLEMENT was outrun early, raced five wide and had no response when roused. DEVINE WIND chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. GLOBAL QUEST was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. ONTHEDEANSLIST chased the pace for three quarters and tired. CLASSIC ENDEAVOR was hustled along outside, chased the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch.
