STAKES New York Stallion Series S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. For Fillies and Mares that have been fully subscribed to The New York Stallion Series (all eligibility requirements met by their three year old season) are eligible to this race. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2016 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than state-bred in 2016, 4 lbs.; of a sweepstake or four races lifetime allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

HIGHWAY STAR four wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun four then three wide into upper stretch straightened away, rallied to collar the front inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear under a drive to prevail. FROSTY MARGARITA veered out after the start and was corrected, raced five wide forwardly placed early on, tucked three wide into the turn and ranged up to take over command midway on the bend, shook away through the latter portion of the turn and swung just off the inside for home, raced clear in hand the rider sneaking a peek back nearing the eighth pole and was roused at that station, dug in drifting out slightly nearing the sixteenth marker, got displaced inside that juncture and ran on to hold for the place honors. SUPER SURPRISE broke in at the start bumping WONDERMENT, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to procure the show honors. FAMILYOFROSES three wide chasing from near the rear, came under encouragement midway on the turn, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid through to the finish. WONDERMENT bumped at the start by SUPER SURPRISE, who broke inwards, saved ground near the rear coming under a ride three furlongs from home, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, passed tired foes in the drive. LADY KREESEA just off the inside near the rear, tucked to the rail seven-sixteenths from home, came under a ride midway on the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. PERFECT FREUD forwardly placed two then three wide through the turn, came under urging at the three-eighths, cornered four wide for home and tired. ROSIE P established the front and showed the way in hand three then two wide into the turn, got headed for command by FROSTY MARGARITA at the three-eighths, chased just off the inside through the latter portion of the turn and continued in that path into upper stretch, then faltered in the lane. STORIED LADY chased three then two wide under encouragement

from the three-eighths and gave way.
