### Footnotes

MISS VALENTINE unhurried for nearly three-quarters, picked up the pace approaching the head of the stretch, rallied in earnest after being straightened away, closed in on the leader, worked her way to the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and dug in with good determination to preserve it. SALTAMONTES away alertly, took charge midway down the backstretch, was taken over to the rail in time for the run around the bend, cut the pace from the there, with the rider applying rating tactics, was asked for a response turning for home, drifted out gradually throughout the stretch drive, yielded near the sixteenth pole, continued onward with good energy for the place, with the rider expertly avoiding contact with the top one as best as possible leaving the sixteenth pole. READYGETSGOLD was put to encouragement coming to the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide into the stretch and came home willingly en route for the show. NICOLE'S MISS EL off slowly, after ducking inward at the start, rushed up into a forward position, was placed under a firm hold once settled in, took the inside route around the turn, had intentions of swinging outward in upper stretch, but was forced to delay the plan until the furlong marker, displayed a mild kick thereafter to grab the last major share. FLOATING ALONE three wide at the quarter pole, was roused in upper stretch but lacked the necessary stretch response. QUEEN'S HARBOR pressed the leader from the outside until midstretch before weakening. YAWKEY WAY three wide, was urged at the three-eighths pole but could not keep pace. HESSONITE off to a sluggish beginning, saved ground and trailed.
