OUTER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination; \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$625 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,250 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights; Three year olds, 123.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 in 2016-17 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2017 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 lifetime or two races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2017 allowed 6 lbs. Preference to start will be determined by Graded Stake winners, Graded Stake placed runners, non-restricted stake winners, condition eligibility. Any ties in conditions will be broken total earnings. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, November 11, 2017 with 26 Original Nominations and 3 Supplements. (Rail at 36 feet).

**Footnotes**

With the starting gate jutting from the outer rail, RAINBOW HEIR settled into the two path after the break, sat reserved within striking distance for the opening half, got angled three wide for the drive home, responded when given its cue and cut into the deficit, shied out briefly and slightly when SUMMATION TIME himself wandered to the outside in midstretch, lost little if any momentum through it all though, closed in reletbntlessly, outfighting a pair of opponents to the inside to take over with under a sixteenth remaining then edged away under good handling. DUBINI began to break to the outside springing from the gate, was pulled off the nearest foe but not before some light contact between the two, got set up in the two path in time for the commencement of the run around the bend, got set down a short distance from the quarter pole, was sent out towards path five during the initial portion of the stretch, straightened away and rallied with good energy to garner the place. CONQUEST PANTHERA darted over to the rail, continued to take it racing towards the back of the pack, stepped into the stretch, was maneuvered to the outside in midstretch, mustered up a late kick strong enough to grab the show award. SUMMATION TIME out-broke the competition, responded to some early hand encouragement to cement himself to the front, set the splits, facing some resistance from others to the outside, completed the half and was asked for more, came out slightly just as the winner was arriving on the

scene in the general area of the eighth pole, leading both that foe and BUCCHERO to involuntarily move a bit towards the middle of the course too, got nailed leaving the sixteenth pole then got swallowed up by several additional rivals in the final stages. BUCCHERO pressed the issue from the two path, rider holding something back in reserve, got let out spinning into the stretch, was induced by the one to catch to shift slightly to the outside in midlane, gave it his best shot from upper stretch to the sixteenth pole before weakening. DOWSE'S BEACH tracked the pacesetter from just off the rail and faltered. WHITE FLAG took up the chase from the two path, went six wide down the lane while backing away. SNOWDAY (FR) saved ground for the initial half, was angled three wide into the stretch, came up empty. BLIND AMBITION bumped lightly with DUBINI after bobbling at the start, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, was already being roused before reaching the quarter pole, lacked the needed response. SPRING TO THE SKY travelled from the two path on the turn, raced seven wide down the lane while not rallying.
