QUEZON chased two to three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, closed well to get up in the final jumps and prevail. PICCO UNO four to five wide in aim of the front, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, dug in and took over command nearing the eighth pole, came under growing threat to the outside and was caught in the final strides. ABSATOOTLY showed the way in hand three then two wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, dug in and was headed a furlong out, weakened in the late stages. KALABAKA four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened. FUSAICHI RED chased five wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung six wide for home, took a bad step in the vicinity of the eighth pole, was immediately protected and eased up but tragically had to be euthanized on track.
