JENA JENA came out running and was quickly well clear of the field while under a stout hold, set the fractions under good handling, drew away again when set down turning for home and was not fully extended under the wire. MISS THERMAL TECH showed good speed from the outside, tried the winner midway on the turn but proved no match for that rival while clearly best of the others. DOC CASELLI was hustled from the gate, roused on the turn and was no real threat with a mild late rally. FINANCIAL LADY was hustled up along the rail after the start, steadied slightly entering the turn then had no rally while racing on the rail. PERFECT REASON was hard-ridden, chased the pace for a half mile and tired. JOVIAL CHARADE was outrun while racing on the rail. WAVE OFF, outrun early, put in a run on the turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. PETRONIA was hard-ridden from the start but had no response.
