JENA JENA quickly made the lead without need of urging, maintained her advantage to the head of the lane then extended it to mid stretch, met a bold bid from DEDA in the final seventy yard but dug back in and held. DEDA settled inside on the backstretch, angled out nearing the quarter pole, responded once straightened for the drive and closed steadily but lugged in late to compromise her bid. MORGAN J. was void of any early speed, came to the extreme outside for the stretch and found her best stride to closed boldly but too late. MY WILD ROSE broke slow and raced unhurried to the stretch then finished in a mild rally. MISTER CRAFTY broke alertly but slipped back early, saved ground on the turn and had no rally. GRENY stalked the winner outside a three horse spread to the stretch and weakened. MS ZENNA stalked the winner from the rail but had nothing left for the drive. LITE TWILIGHT tracked the pace between horses to the quarter pole and stopped.
