FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each on or before May 20, 2006 or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 each by the time of closing of entries Friday, May 26, 2006. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, May 27. If the race is moved to the main track after the time of closing, a horse may be scratched for any reason at any time up to fifteen (15) minutes prior to post time for the race preceding this race or thereafter with a valid physical reason and approved by the stewards. The entry fee shall be refunded for scratches made in compliance with the above conditions. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 20, 2006 with 30 nominations.

Footnotes

RUSH BAY went up early to press front-running FREE THINKING in hand, raced three wide, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch, then held off PURIM in a stiff drive. PURIM, reserved in behind pacesetting FREE THINKING, raced with in easy striking distance, angled four wide into the stretch, loomed menacingly, appeared to be struck in the face by the whip of RUSH BAY'S rider nearing the sixteenth pole, then couldn't get up. FREE THINKING gained the lead inside early, managed modest fractions, showed the way to the stretch and weakened. ON THE ACORN (GB), sluggish to start, raced near the inside and failed to rally. SENOR SWINGER followed the leaders within striking distance four or five wide into the stretch and was empty when the test came.
