KODEMA challenged for the early lead, drove clear and was kept to the task. SPRITELY WALKER raced within contention, came around the second turn four wide, made a bid, couldn't catch the leader, but got up for second. PRINCE SLEW lacked early speed, raced four wide around the second turn, made a late bid and finished willingly. PARROTT BAY void of early speed, came around the final turn four wide and made a late gain. CLASSIC PAR raced in the middle of the pack in the beginning, eased back, made a bid after turning for home and hit his best stride late. NO ITS NOT was an early factor, then faded. CROWNED KING always raced near the back, came around the first turn three wide and was no threat. WINNING FANS vied for the early lead, saved ground and dropped back.
