### Footnotes

DIAMOND FEVER, well placed close to the pace, moved up outside rivals to challenge for and gain the lead in midstretch then WHEELS UP AT NOON safe under pressure. WHEELS UP AT NOON raced close up along the inside rail, worked his way out for room in upper stretch and responded well in the drive to close the gap. DINNER IN ODEM moved closer leaving the far turn and finished willingly. RETURN THE MONEY, never far back, finished with good energy to close the gap. REBEL YELLER prompted the pace two abreast, loomed boldly through the stretch but was not good enough. FAT MAN WALKIN raced within striking distance but lacked a solid rally. DISCO INDY saved ground setting the pace then weakened in the drive. Portable inner rail set at 15 feet.
