QUIET DOWN stalked the pace, loomed boldly through the stretch but was not good enough. MY AMANDARI, never far back, lacked the needed rally. LADY BEELZEBUB prompted the pace for six furlongs then weakened. VIA SACRA failed to threaten. FINAL ASSAULT was well placed close to the pace for six furlongs then tired.
