NATES MINESHAFT was well rated while off the inside, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, accelerated further clear and drew off under steady urging. MISSION IMPAZIBLE was reserved on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. TOBY'S CORNER went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. MISTER MARTI GRAS raced off the rail on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, steadied along the rail nearing the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide shortly thereafter, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. PANTS ON FIRE bumped with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, went four then three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. REDEEMED was reserved while off the inside, came under urging midway through the far turn and failed to respond. FAST ALEX bumped with rivals at the start, shifted three wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, advanced five then four wide on the far turn but had nothing left. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, went three then two wide on the far turn and faded.
