SWING AND SWAY well placed and three wide, shook clear through the turn, drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. TIZNOW'S SMILE broke awkwardly from the gate, saved ground through the turn, came through inside into the lane, angled widest and closed fast for the place. DOWNTOWN AT NOON allowed to settle, looped up three and four wide through the turn, bid four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RIBBONITE chased the pace on the inside, angled out through the turn, bid three wide into the lane and faded the final furlong, holding a share. FILIBUSTIN vied for the early lead from between rivals, lost some ground through the turn, bid between into the lane and faded in the drive. RIP LOVES MAIZE was a brief factor. CLARA'S GONE WEST set the early pace off the rail, stayed on when challenged through the turn, then had no stretch rally.
