EL GATO MALO raced within easy striking distance of a slow pace under confident handling to the second turn, set out after MANY RIVERS leaving the three eighths pole, took command from the rail into the lane, battled briefly then drew clear to win handily and the rider merely waving the whip in his face. BERT'S LAW raced unhurried from off the rail early, came through inside on the second turn, remained on the rail for the drive and finished steadily. MANY RIVERS set all of the pace from off the rail, resisted the winner briefly into the lane then weakened leaving the furlong pole. CAFE TORTONI was permitted to settle early from off the rail, tried to rally four wide on the second turn, shifted inward for the drive but could not offer a serious bid. VALID PORT lagged to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but did not rally. VADHEIM had no speed. NSYNC LYNX stalked the pace outside for six furlongs and came up empty. DEPUTY BERTRANDO tracked the pace inside to the second turn and gave out while three wide then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
