### Footnotes

RICH PEACE chased the pace four wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. RHUBARB RED showed speed racing three wide, increased her margin in midstretch, then just failed to last. SILK CONCORDE chased the pace three wide, angled outside the leader for the drive and was gaining slowly at the finish. CHEEKS EIGHTYEIGHT reserved racing along the inside, lacked a late response. MISS ANNIE BEA allowed to settle, steadied when caught in tight racing down the backstretch, angled to the inside leaving the turn and failed to threaten. KIMBERLY'S KINGDOM trailed after being steadied at the start, then was eased in the final eighth.
