Footnotes

CASHEL CASTLE, lightly rated near the inside from early on, eased out three wide approaching the stretch to go after pacesetting LAFFIT, took over from that one leaving the quarter-mile ground, quickly opened a clear advantage and widened a bit in the late stages when ridden out as much the best. GOVERNOR HICKEL, eased off the inside early, raced four wide on the backstretch and around the turn, ranged up outside the winner for the drive but couldn't menace as second best. SKY TERRACE drifted out a bit at the start, raced five or six wide much of the way and wasn't a serious threat while improving position. LAFFIT gained the lead early, raced two or three wide while showing the way, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened thereafter. CICERO GRIMES pressed front-running LAFFIT for about a half and tired gradually. STORM COMMANDER forced the pace four or five wide until nearing the stretch and gave way readily in the drive.
