GOOD AND TOUGH, lightly rated along the rail from early on, was patiently handled, remained along the inside entering the stretch and was under mild hand urging to prove clearly best. PURPLE PASSION drifted in at the start and lightly bumped CRUCIBLE, went up to press that one from the outside, loomed prominently in the drive but wasn't a match for GOOD AND TOUGH. CRUCIBLE, lightly bumped soon after at the start while gaining the lead, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. LORD GRILLO (ARG), never far back, came out five wide for the drive but failed to respond. MINT saved ground to no avail.
