STAKES Maker's Mark Mile S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

For four year olds and upward. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to enter and start. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of Grade I or II stakes on the turf since October 8 allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 on the turf since August 1, 5 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf since July 1, 7 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Maker's Mark Mile will be limited to ten. In the event that more than ten pass the entry box, the ten starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2000-2001. Same owner entry cannot start to the exclusion of a single entry. Closed April 4, 2001 with 33 nominations. HAGGIN COURSE.

**Footnotes**

NORTH EAST BOUND, close up from the start, pressed front-running STRATEGIC MISSION under a long rating hold, edged after that one nearing the stretch, reached the front just before the eighth pole, then, after the rider switched his whip to the left hand, drifted out late while holding BRAHMS safe. The latter, well placed inside under light restraint from the start, saved ground into the stretch, angled out to split foes three wide at the furlong grounds, loomed menacingly outside the winner, was forced out by that one in the late going and hung. STRATEGIC MISSION accelerated suddenly on the first turn to gain a clear advantage while maneuvering inside, made the pace into the final furlong and weakened grudgingly. QUIET RESOLVE, nicely placed in behind the leaders early, raced between foes, advanced four wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat and was checked lightly when forced out in the final 70 yards when BRAHMS was forced out. EXCHANGE RATE, sluggish to start, saved ground throughout and could gain only slightly in the drive. NORTHCOTE ROAD, within easy striking distance although racing five or six wide most of the way, weakened when the test came. INKATHA (FR) angled inside early, saved ground into the stretch, worked his way out five wide for the drive but flattened out. MORAVA, six or seven wide most of the way, was finished upon going six furlongs.
