Footnotes

WANDERIN BOY, bumped lightly at the start by PALLADIO, quickly gained a clear lead, raced under light restraint while in in the two path, turned back a mild challenge entering the far turn from ALUMNI HALL from the inside, was well clear entering the upper stretch and widened a bit at the end under solid hand urging while drifting out slightly in the final sixteenth. ALUMNI HALL, up close from early on while two or three wide, offered an earnest challenge between calls entering the far turn, remained inside the winner to the lane, drifted out a bit at the eighth pole and couldn't threaten the winner as second best. NOBLE CAUSEWAY, closer than usual and well placed in hand near the inside, angled three or four wide approaching the stretch, was five wide for the drive, then, after the rider misjudged the finish line and rose prematurely at the alternate finish line a sixteenth out, was not ridden the remainder and narrowly held the show position on his own courage. COSMONAUT popped the stalls doors open prior to the start. During the running, COSMONAUT tracked the winner from early on while four wide was just off WANDERIN BOY entering the stretch and flattened out. PALLADIO came out bumping the winner at the start and was finished upon going six furlongs. IT'S NO JOKE popped the doors of his starting stall open prior to the start. During the running, IT'S NO JOKE broke in the air, raced four or five wide and tired gradually after going six furlongs.
