Footnotes

PAMPERED PRINCESS went up early to press front-running TAMWEEL four wide in hand, inched to the front just prior to going six furlongs, was headed from the outside about the three-sixteenths pole by CAPESIDE LADY, recaptured the top position leaving the furlong grounds and edged clear under strong handling. PLEASANT HOME, unhurried to the far turn while three wide, made a run from between rivals five or six wide nearing the final quarter, then couldn't challenge the winner at the end while gamely earning the place. CAPESIDE LADY stalked the pace five wide from early on, reached the front entering the upper stretch, battled with the winner into the final furlong and couldn't keep pace. BENDING STRINGS, nicely positioned in behind the leaders from the outset, pulled the rider forward nearing the end of the backstretch while three wide, moved five wide into the lane and was empty when the test came. MISS FORTUNATE, within easy striking distance, raced six wide around the far turn and failed to respond. ISOLA PIU BELLA (CHI), never far back and three or four wide, also lacked a rally. WINNING SEASON gained a striking position early, followed the pace four wide, was asked for more leaving the three-furlong marker and failed to comply. SANTA CANDIDA (ARG), three or four wide most of the way, never reached contention. HALORY LEIGH drifted out a bit at the start, raced five or six wide throughout and never menaced. TAMWEEL gained a clear advantage early while edging in two or three wide, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and faded. GO GIRLFRIEND GO was outrun.
