**Footnotes**

OCEAN DRIVE stalked the pace from the early stages while lightly rated five wide, moved gradually approaching the stretch to challenge, was carried out a bit by SAND SPRINGS at the quarter-mile ground, wrested command, quickly drew clear and was kept to her task in the drive. SAND SPRINGS gained a clear advantage approaching the first turn, raced four wide while showing the way, drifted out at the quarter-mile ground carrying the winner and PROM DATE out slightly, was straightened for the drive but weakened. MOONLIGHT SONATA, taken in hand early, raced three or four wide, swung out eight wide entering the stretch and offered a mild late gain while not a serious threat. FABULOUS BRUSH, close up inside from early on, was asked for her best approaching the final quarter, loomed prominently inside the leaders, came out three wide but weakened when the real test came. PROM DATE, unhurried early and six wide much of the way, was carried out slightly at the quarter-mile ground, then flattened out the last eighth. FLYING DOVE, a bit rank during the opening quarter, settled in behind horses three or four wide, continued along the inside into the stretch and never menaced while improving position. WILD BUT WORTH IT moved near the inside early, raced in contention for six furlongs, swung out six wide for the drive but was empty. LIL SCOUT, rated in behind front-running SAND SPRINGS early while three or four wide, was put to an all out drive while between horses two or three wide approaching the stretch but faded.
