PRIVATE RYAN was taken to rate along the inside, eased out some near the three furlong marker, surged clear approaching the quarter pole, drew off in mid stretch then maintained a comfortable margin under a right handed drive. COWBOY MAGIC saved ground while unhurried, advanced between rivals into the stretch and battled gamely to earn a tie for the place. P DAY was taken back after the break, settled off the rail down the backstretch, commenced a four wide run leaving the three furlong marker and finished gamely to be on even terms with COWBOY MAGIC. EXCLUSIVE RUN stalked the pace off the rail, came four wide for the drive and passed tiring rivals. FIRST AMENDMENT quickly reached the front, set a solid pace along the inside, was collared by the winner after six and a half furlongs then surrendered in upper stretch. CONCERNED MINISTER broke a step slow, angled off the heels of EXCLUSIVE RUN nearing the first turn, rushed up three wide to reach contention, prompted the pace two wide to the three eighth's pole then faltered.
