FETCH DINNER was hustled clear rating the pace while drifting outward on the backstretch, came back in saving ground through the turn then responded willingly through the stretch to remain clear. RICH IN GLORY, a step slow to start, was allowed to settle in stride near the back, angled in saving ground through the turn, started his bid on the rail from the upper stretch, took place a sixteenth out and held well. UNREAL PARTY was hustled up taking good early position in the three path, was carried outward through the backstretch, took aim three or four wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch. SOUTHLAND BLUES broke sharply inward bumping Summer Swing at the break, saved ground on the turn, was eased to mid track making his bid in the stretch and closed finishing evenly. DIXIE TWO THOUSAND was bumped at the start, rated close to the lead in mid track, gave chase five wide through the turn then tired in the drive. SUMMER SWING broke awkwardly then was bumped hard at the start, chased the pace toward the outside then tired widest leaving the turn.
