ONE EYED JOKER was brushed at the start, raced just off the pace, moved to contention into the far turn, assumed the lead leaving the quarter pole then drew clear and kept to task. PUNKIN HEAD angled out at the break and brushed One Eyed Joker then raced off the pace, moved to position in the far turn, was bothered in the upper stretch when Star Over the Bay came in on him, lacked room to the eighth pole then rallied when clear. STAR OVER THE BAY was rated back, advanced on the outside of the far turn, swerved in and steadied in the upper stretch then ran evenly for the remainder of the stretch. WALTZIN' STORM was rated close up, steadied into the first turn, took the lead into the far turn, dueled between horses in the upper stretch then weakened near the eighth pole. TOLL CARD raced close inside, was boxed in on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and offered no rally. FAST LINE, off the pace, advanced through the far turn, lost momentum into the stretch then lacked a rally. RIVER POWER rated the pace, dropped back a notch on the rail into the far turn then tired in the stretch. NOUVEAU RICHE was jostled at the start, took a brief lead then stalked the pace and faded from the half mile pole.
