Footnotes

HERITAGE OF GOLD showed no early speed, found her best strides entering the far turn while caught five wide, circled the field with an impressive turn of foot, took command in upper stretch from HARPIA and drew clear late under steady right handed whipping. HARPIA attended to the pace early while three wide, vied for command along the backstretch with SILENT ESKIMO, took control at the half mile pole, opened up a clear advantage on the final turn, was roused in upper stretch, lost the lead to HERITAGE OF GOLD in upper stretch and was clearly second best. TAP TO MUSIC rated very nicely early while three wide, stalked the pacemakers four wide down the backside, made a more determined bid for the lead while three wide on the final turn, had HARPIA in her sights in upper stretch and failed to carry her momentum in the final stages. SILENT ESKIMO a bit slow into stride at the start, recovered to set the pace early, was hooked by HARPIA entering the backstretch, lost the lead at the half-mile pole, was roused very hard on the final turn and had no answer when asked in the stretch. JILL'S LIL GIRL was in close attendance to the leaders while racing along the rail and failed to keep up with the leaders on the final turn. LICENSE FEE chased four wide, improved her position nicely while still very wide down the backstretch, made a bid for the lead while five wide on the final turn and hung badly.
