QUIET GIANT stalked outside, bid three wide on the far turn, responded when asked, drew away and was taken in hand late. LACIE SLEW raced off the pace, swung wide into the stretch and rallied for second. DEBONAIR DARLING bobbled at the break, raced close up inside, came three wide into the stretch and rallied mildly between foes. SUCCESSFUL SONG pressed the pace, bid between rivals on the turn and weakened. CHECK POINT was outrun early and passed tired foes. REMIT was off slowly, settled off the rail, made a four wide run on the far turn and flattened out. C C'S PAL set the pace on the inside, duled on the far turn and gave way.
