APPREHENDER took over soon after the start, narrowly showed the way through the turn in the two path, shook clear of the other speed nearing the furlong grounds, displayed good late mettle to hold the runner up safe late. ALSVID forwardly placed early inside, boxed in while continuing along the rail turn, moved out a bit for the drive, clean to the wire, outkicked. LAURIE'S ROCKET within striking distance off the inside, pulled, shuffled back a bit in the turn, came five wide into the stretch, along for the show while no threat to the top pair late. BET THE POWER behind the pace, three wide through the turn when within contact of the leaders, lacked a finishing kick the final furlong. HAMAZING DESTINY broke alertly, pressured the winner from the outside for a half, weakened in the drive. READY FOR MORE fell back soon after the start, trailed, moved out to be five wide turning for home, failed to muster a rally.
