THE HAPPY HOPPER never far back off the rail, went after the leader late in the turn, collared that one soon after, drew clear then held DREAMS GALLORE safe late. The latter, a bit slow away, raced well back under restrained, was in traffic late in the turn, angled to the far outside for the drive and finished well to be getting to the winner. STORMIN HANNA broke alertly, got quickly clear, set the pace for just over a half and weakened slightly. CASINO DOLL bore in at the start bothering several rivals, advanced four wide in the turn then flattened out final furlong. EXPENSIVE SLEW forced the pace off the inside for four furlongs and weakened. QUICK GREY took up at the start and lost all chance. GOOD TIMIN BROOK tired in the drive as did SINTRESS. BRASS DOLL, bothered at the start, failed to menace. ANSWER TO JORDAN gave way early.
