BLUES BLASTER took command at once and set all of the pace under fine rating, responded in the upper stretch and held gamely. EAGLE SCREAMS prompted the winner two wide from the outset, had his best challenges from the quarter pole to the furlong pole then could not quite match strides. OUTSIDE NASHVILLE raced unhurried early but was always within striking distance, advanced three wide to loom a bold factor once in the stretch but lost his punch. G. G. RYDER was settled early and stalked the pace from the inside to the stretch then lacked a closing response. ZEEWAT lagged early from the rail, came three wide on the second turn but could only muster a mild rally. PEPPER CROWN turned in a dull effort. BOYETT stalked the pace three wide to the second turn and came up empty.
