TRIBAL GAL raced up inside to gain a short advantage in the opening quarter, disposed of HANDFUL OF PEARLS once in the stretch to take a clear lead and held driving. UNUSUAL WAY was never too far back, advanced three wide on the turn but flattened out in the lane. TOP KISSER raced unhurried early, saved ground and came on late. BRILLIANT MELODY settled early, was two wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. SUDDEN SUNDAY lagged from the outset then failed to respond while two wide on the turn. HANDFUL OF PEARLS dueled outside the winner to the stretch and gave out. QIAONA lacked good early speed, tried to rally four wide but came up empty. MARKS MINE tracked the leaders to the turn but gave way suddenly. QUIZZICAL showed little.
