Footnotes

CAINAM settled in the back of the pack early, steadily began to advance position heading into the turn, raced five wide in the turn, surged past rivals along the outside at the top of the lane, took command from WINGS OF WAR in the late stretch and held clear. WINGS OF WAR stalked the top two pacesetters, made a bid heading into the turn, took command from KATE'S MAIN MAN in the upper stretch but could not hold off late charging CAINAM in the drive. LAUNCH LIGHT took the early lead by a slight margin, continued along the inside but could not keep up the pace in the stretch. WEST ALBANY saved ground racing along the inside and lacked a late needed rally in the drive. RUNAWAY WALKAWAY stalked the early front runners, raced three wide in the turn and had no late kick in the stretch. KATE'S MAIN MAN raced up close early, edged up and took command midway into the far turn but could sustain bid and steadily weakened.
