Footnotes

ANGELICA SLEW was bumped at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, vied three wide early on the turn, took the lead near the five-sixteenths marker, responded gamely to the challenge of WACKY PATTY in upper stretch and proved best under strong handling. WACKY PATTY settled off the pace, advanced while three wide on the turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch but was turned away and settled for second. ANTARTIDA (ARG) was well placed on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong while clear for third. LADY SONYA was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. RICH MUSIQUE dueled on the inside, vied past the quarter-pole and faded. DILOOT broke outward and bumped a rival then bobbed a bit, settled off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and never reached contention. JABIBITI (PER) broke inward at the start and jostled with a rival, dueled on the outside, dropped out near the three-furlong marker and stopped.
