Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of entry. Weights: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 twice in 2020 allowed 2 lbs., \$18,000 once in 2020, 4 lbs., \$15,000 in 2020, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming Races Not Considered). High Weights Preferred, Then Highest Lifetime Earnings of horses with equal weights. Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. The guaranteed money and OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. (S)

SHE'S ALL WOLFE stalked the pace then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a long drive then the rider lost his whip nearing the furlong marker and held sway in the final strides. SPECIAL TREASURE dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive then gamely dug in throughout the stretch and was outfinished in late stretch. CHEROKEE COWGIRL dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then faltered in late stretch. OKIE BECKAROO was slow early then made a late turn of foot in the stretch and was no threat. SEEING DOUBLE was unhurried early then made a mild rally and was no threat. JULIARD HONOR chased the early pace while three wide then bore out while being hard used then stopped.
