Footnotes

A TOAST TO YOU tracked pace while slightly off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, angled out further, roused then rallied strongly and nailed inside rival in final strides. AIN'T NO OTHER stalked from between rivals down the hill, came out slightly departing the hill, rallied then struck the front inside sixteenth marker, inched away but could not stave off the winner. TIZ A MINISTER was off tardily, chased from the inside then bit off the fence, swung out five wide entering the stretch, closed furiously from the far outside and got up in final jump for third. CIRCA'SGOLDENGEAR tucked in behind dueling leaders, came out slightly leaving the hill, moved up between foes in mid-stretch, loomed passing sixteenth marker but was nailed on the wire for third. LUCKARACK settled off the leaders while steered to the rail, chased from the inside down the hill and into the lane, came out slightly in the drive and finished strongly from between foes. STARSPANGLED HEAT unhurried initially, hugged the fence down the hill, remained inside into the stretch, roused then rallied from between rivals while finding his best stride late. MOBILIZED reserved while bit off the rail, raced on two wide path to the stretch and passed tiring rivals. STRONG WIND forced then dueled outside rival down the hill, gained advantage entering the stretch, edged away under urging, but surrendered the lead passing sixteenth marker then weakened. ATTA BOY PETE rushed up from the inside to grab brief lead, contested the pace inside rival, dropped back bit in upper stretch then retreated in late going. DIXIELAND BLUES broke alertly but was taken off the leaders, tracked pace from off the rail then five wide departing the hill, gave way readily through the stretch, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. Rail at 14 feet on the hill.
