FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 in 2016-17 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2016-17 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2017 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2017 allowed 8 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 8, 2017 with 24 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.) (Rail at 12 feet).

MISS ELLA three wide at the rear early, tucked inside with seven-sixteenths to go patiently handled as her rivals got busy midway on the turn, tipped out with five-sixteenths to run as PRETTY PERFECTION steadied in front along the inside, continued the angle outwards to spin four wide into upper stretch, came under hand urging three-sixteenths from home, rallied to issue a challenge through the final eighth splitting foes just inside the sixteenth marker to take command seventy yards from home, inched away to the finish under a stout hand drive while never having the stick applied through the stretch to the finish. FAIR POINT four then three wide near the rear, remained patiently handled through the turn until put to light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied willingly outside the aforementioned foe but couldn't match her late while along for the place honors. CAROLINA SHAG three to four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole under threat from a pair to the outside, dug in and was caught seventy yards from the finish, ran on clear for the show honors. RUBY NOTION prompted the pace of PAQUITA COQUETA four then three wide through the turn under urging from the five-sixteenths, spun three

wide into upper stretch, weakened in the final furlong. PAQUITA COQUETA (CHI) hustled from the start, cut the pace lightly coaxed along just off the inside under pressure through swift splits, got roused spinning just off the inside for home, dug in under threat and yielded just inside the eighth pole, weakened through the late stages. PRETTY PERFECTION broke out at the start and bumped with EVERYTHING LOVELY, chased the pace along the inside in range of the front, had the rail get tightened up nearing the five-sixteenths by EVERYTHING LOVELY in the two path and was forced to steady when bounced lightly off the temporary rail at that station losing some ground and momentum as a result, spun just off the inside for home, angled out and improved position in the final furlong. MISSISSIPPI DELTA chased just off the inside under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, made no impact. SUMMER READING three wide in pursuit under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, angled six wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. EVERYTHING LOVELY bumped at the start by PRETTY PERFECTION who broke outwards, chased just off the inside in aim of the leader, had the leader come in ever so slightly and closed up the inside a bit forcing PRETTY PERFECTION to steady in tight down along her inside when put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, weakened in the drive.
