DREAM SUPREME raced close up inside while in hand, angled out into the stretch, came back to the inside in midstretch, split rivals and drew clear under a drive. COUNTRY HIDEAWAY was hustled along between rivals, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. BOURBON BELLE raced close up outside while in hand, put in a three wide run on the turn, led into midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. HONEST LADY, taken to the rail on the backstretch, was blocked along the inside nearing the stretch then was forced to steady when in tight quarters on the rail in midstretch. CASSIDY chased the pace from the outside and had no response when roused. CASH RUN stumbled at the start, was hustled up inside to set the pace and was steadied in tight quarters in midstretch. TROPICAL PUNCH raced three wide and had no response when roused. DEBBY D'OR contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. JOANA ALEGRE (CHI) raced inside and had no response when roused. A claim of foul against the winner by the trainer of the CASH RUN, alleging interference in the stretch, was dismissed.
