Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2016 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2016 allowed 8 lbs. RACHEL'S TEMPER was guided in at the rear of the field, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear while well behind the fast pace, was urged along while two then three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide while advancing near the five-sixteenths, rallied outside into upper stretch, closed strongly under a hand ride to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under a mild hand ride to win ridden out. TIGER RIDE went around the first turn in the three path, settled in third position behind the leading duo, advanced three wide on the far turn, took the lead at the five-sixteenths, dropped closer to the rail while moving clear outside the quarter-pole, was set down in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip inside the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to hold the place. SWEETGRASS dropped in entering the first turn, made her way to the rail early on that bend, settled off the pace, advanced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, waited behind the tiring leaders from the three-eighths pole to near the quarter-pole, was asked once let through by the jockeys brother at that point, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was out-kicked. ESKENFORMONEY was caught in the four path on the first turn, came under urging before the five-eighths pole, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn, shifted four wide while moving closer at the three-eighths, was put to a right-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch then faltered. MONEY'SONCHARLOTTE moved through along the rail into the first turn, set the pace on the inside through fast fractions, lost the lead before the five-sixteenths, dropped back under the whip in upper stretch and tired. MILAYA pressed the fast pace on the outside while racing in the two path, dropped back late on the far turn, had the jockey let his sibling through outside the quarter-pole in a piece of brotherly love, came three wide into the stretch and faded.
