**Footnotes**

CUT OF MUSIC unhurried and taken inside, waited for room leaving the second turn, got through along the rail into the stretch, rallied to gain a short lead leaving the furlong marker, lugged in some late but held on under steady handling. WESTWARD STAR forced in at the start, soon sprinted clear, set the pace inside, drifted out some into the stretch, battled gamely to hold on, was overtaken leaving the furlong marker, never relented but had to settle for second best. BIG SWED kept close inside, was blocked through the second turn, angled outside WESTWARD STAR into the stretch, bumped VIGILANT SITE, rallied belatedly from outside and narrowly missed second. NEWARK made up ground off the rail on the backstretch, progressed three wide on the second turn, was crowded and altered out into the stretch and gradually brought inward through the lane. VIGILANT SITE broke inward, pressed WESTWARD STAR from just outside, was bumped and forced out entering the stretch, taken inside once clear then drifted out nearing the wire. MOODY SLEW well placed outside for more than a half mile, gave way four wide on the second turn. COUNT REMAINS forced in and steadied at the start, was quickly far behind and stayed there. An objection by the rider of VIGILANT SITE and the trainer of NEWARK was lodged against BIG SWED for interference into the stretch. After their review, the stewards disqualified BIG SWED and placed him fifth.
