CURLIN'S HONOR was out well, made an early bid for the lead racing along the inside, saved ground, drifted just off of the rail entering the stretch, dueled with VERBOTEN early in the stretch and kicked clear in the final furlong. VERBOTEN broke outwards, pressed the pace racing on the outside, was three-wide on the turn, dueled in early stretch but was outfinished and held place. SUPREME AURA settled early, trailed the field while in range, raced two-wide on the turns, angled out coming into the stretch and closed well despite missing place. MARCUS broke outwards, stalked the pace racing on the inside, saved ground on the turn and chased in the stretch. BE VEWEY VEWEY QUIET bobbled and broke outwards, split foes to force the pace, raced two-wide on the turn, pressed the leaders turning for home but yielded.
