**Footnotes**

STRAIT FROM TEXAS raced four wide, ranged up in hand heading into the stretch, was asked for run in mid stretch, and rallied to take over late. CHOPININA advanced to press the pace inside of MULRAINY, came off the rail shortly after the eleven sixteenths pole, controlled the pace on the turn under pressure, gave her best inside through the stretch while giving way late. BYZANTINE bumped at the start, raced three wide, and rallied mildly four wide. ONE FOR ROSE broke outwards, stalked the pace three wide, pressed the pace outside of the runner up on the turn, gave way in mid stretch. FIVE FISHES (FR) raced inside, gradually came off the rail on the turn to be six wide for the drive, rallied late. MADAME CERITO raced off the rail, gained mildly five wide in the stretch. HOT TALENT bumped at the start, was three wide while between horses, advanced mildly in mid stretch, was outfinished late. FIRST QUARTER raced inside, was in tight and steadied behind the fading pace setter going into the stretch, came off the rail in upper stretch and was not a threat. MULRAINY had speed to clear early while off the rail, came under pressure after two furlongs, dropped down to the rail when the runner up moved outside of her, gave way on the turn, and faded.
