Footnotes

DESERT WAVES assumed command between horses and set a slow pace just off the rail, shook off rivals in upper stretch and gained a length advantage, then held off the late charge off CROWN ATTORNEY in an all out drive. The latter was unhurried early, rallied 5 wide around the turn and closed the gap, but could not get the winner in the drive. DOWN THE AISLE stalked the early pace between horses, closed the gap 3 wide at the 3/8 pole and finished evenly. PINAFORE PARK was in hand and stalked the early pace along the rail, then weakened in the stretch. VICTOR COOLEY was in hand and stalked the early pace 4 wide, but lacked a late response. SKY COLONY stalked the pace between horses, was close up around the turn, but flattened out in the drive. SKI MAKER was close up between horses, but lacked a late response and was never a threat.
