Footnotes

MISS MO MENTUM chased along in mid pack before commencing a two to four wide bid for the front turning for home, continued to drive on the leader to just outside the sixteenth pole when she got the front and held off all closers late. HOT CASH settled off the pace while three to four wide on both turns, rallying in upper stretch relentlessly while widest to garner the place spot late. DIXIE MOON sat a perfect pocket trip behind the pacesetter along the inside until upper stretch, angled out and lost her path before clearing traffic by the sixteenth pole, closing inside the place horse late. TAPA TAPA TAPA set a moderate pace and was put to pressure by rivals late on the far turn, seemed to shrug off the challengers in upper stretch but was no match late, giving up

positions grudgingly inside the seventy yard pole. LUNAR GARDEN stalked the leader three wide on the first turn and two wide on the second turn before bidding for the front at the quarter pole but could not match the energy of her rivals late in the stretch drive. GIOVANNA BLUES settled off the pace and was near the back of the pack midway on the far turn, came off the rail coming into the stretch and lost her path by the eighth pole, swinging out and closing very well in the final seventy yards. SHE'S THE BERRIES rated off the pace and moved into mid pack while two to three wide on the final turn, angled out by the eighth pole and encountered some traffic but had no further rally and levelled off late. SUMMER LUCK stalked three to four wide on the first turn, staying three wide on the far turn but had no response in the stretch and fell back the final sixteenth. BEAR PAW stalked from the two path throughout, hustled by her rider midway on the far turn but fell back down the stretch. LADIES NIGHT was five to four wide on the first turn stalking the pace, still five wide on the second turn before dropping back from before the quarter pole to the finish.
