Winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 four times in 2006, additional 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice in 2006, 5 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once in 2006, 7 lbs.; Of \$47,940 in 2006, 9 lbs. (Maiden or claiming races not considered) (No Canadian Bred Allowance) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$3,000, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$12,420 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Nominations closed Wednesday, August 23, 2006 with 25.

HIDE AND CHIC stalked the duel; closed three-deep late turn, bid at the top of the stretch, was headed briefly but reasserted herself and drove clear. MARYFIELD bid at the 1/2, vied from the rail, took a short lead on the turn, drove clear briefly at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner but held the place. BEAUTIFUL BETS stalked from between rivals, came four-wide into the stretch, finished gamely but needed more. WHISPERTOASCREAM, well back early between horses, closed on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch and willingly, but late. LA TRILLIUM raced midpack, closed along the rail late turn, chased, but evened out in the final sixteenth. MISS CONCERTO raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, rallied mildly but was not a threat. QUITE A RUCKUS vied briefly, chased four-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. ANNIKA LASS dueled on the backstretch, chased hard between foes on the turn then tired in the stretch. HIGH BUTTON SHOES raced off the pace four-wide, tucked in a bit late turn and tired.
