FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$125 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,250 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight: 122 lbs. Winners of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 at a mile or over, or a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 three times at any distance, additional 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 twice at any distance, allowed 3 lbs. Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 once, 5 lbs.; Of a race other than maiden or claiming or restricted allowance at a mile or over, 7 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 23 Nominations plus 1 Supplement) *Plus up to \$18,900 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. *ALL HORSES WILL BE SUBJECT TO ALCOHOL AND GAMING COMMISSION OF ONTARIO OUT OF COMPETITION TESTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 39 OF THE RULES OF THOROUGHBRED RACING.

SOLIDIFY broke outwards, dropped back and quickly went to the inside, raced two-wide near the back on the opening turn, angled to the outside on the backstretch, commenced a rally while racing four-wide on the far turn, drove to the lead in the stretch and proved best. TRIPWIRE bumped with INCLUSIVE at the start, stalked the pace while racing on the inside, maintained position down the backstretch, saved ground, came off of the rail entering the stretch, launched a bid and finished gamely but was second best. SIR WINSTON raced in midpack, was three-wide on the clubhouse turn, raced near the back into the far turn, entered that turn racing two-wide, angled five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. GRIMGRINNIN' GHOST showed brief speed but quickly took back, saved ground, trailed the field into the far turn, angled out midway around the far turn and closed down the outside. INCLUSIVE bumped with TRIPWIRE at the start, raced in midpack, was two-wide on the opening turn, was near the back heading into the far turn, saved ground, launched a bid entering the stretch, had to steady as CHUCK WILLIS lugged inwards but came again when he found room. JAMMIN STILL bumped into CHUCK WILLIS at the start, tracked the pacesetter while racing two-wide, was between foes on the far turn, fell back a bit and chased in the stretch. NASHTRICK raced widest, was four-wide in midpack on the opening turn, stalked down the backstretch, commenced a bid at the 3/8ths pole racing three-wide, made the lead briefly entering the stretch but weakened. CHUCK WILLIS (IRE) was bumped by JAMMIN STILL at the start, got out to set the pace, was headed midway around the turn and tired in the stretch while lugging in.
