APT TO BE raced close up three wide, rallied in the stretch then could not get past the winner in the drive. KODEMA raced between horses near the middle of the field, rallied closer in the stretch then lacked a winning bid. COACH JIMI LEE raced near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. ATTACK THE BOOKS lacked speed and passed a pair of beaten rivals. WIGGINS set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. FIGHTING INDIANS was always outrun.
