CALIBRACHOA stalked outside, rallied three wide into the stretch, gained a short lead nearing the sixteenth pole, edged away and held well late. CALEB'S POSSE trailed early, angled out at the top of the lane, closed willingly outside and was gaining late. EMCEE dueled outside for command, dug in between rivals at the furlong marker and stayed on gamely to the end. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN raced off the pace inside, angled out for the drive and rallied mildly. ROYAL CURRIER dueled inside, dug in gamely in upper stretch, then weakened. JUSTIN PHILLIP chased inside and tired.
