PICCO UNO coaxed from the gate, vied briefly before showing the way in hand three then two wide, got set down spinning just off the inside for home, drew clear under a drive to prevail. COZZY SPRING hustled from the start, chased three wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, cornered three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and ran on dueling to the finish with HOLIDAY DISGUISE and bested that rival for the place honors. HOLIDAY DISGUISE four then three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on through the stretch latched on to the aforementioned foe but could not go by to the wire while well clear of the rest. ABSATOOTLY six paths off the inside early on, tucked to the two path five furlongs out and then to the inside with half a mile to go, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, bid mildly spinning two to three wide into upper stretch before weakening in the final furlong. BLUEGRASS FLAG coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside under a ride from midway on the turn, spun three wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. BOBBY'S SONG five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path with half a mile remaining, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired.
