By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination; \$925 to pass the entry box and an additional \$950 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,875 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2019-20 or \$150,000 since October 1, 2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2019-20 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-bred allowance in 2019-20 allowed 6 lbs. RATAJKOWSKI away without apparent mishap, established the top by the top of the backstretch, slid onto the inside route, was lightly hand urged cutting the pace, tailed by MISS MISCHIEF to the outside, continued along on the same scenario until the end of the bend, swung into the lane, arrived at the three-sixteenths marker and was asked for her best, gave a response, emerging at the furlong holding her largest lead, saw the runner up closing in readily late but kept going well enough long enough to prevail. MRS. ORB brushed with NO HAYNE NO GAYNE at the start, showed no ill effects from that mild bump despite winding up at the back of the pack during the initial stages, raced three to four wide on the turn, as the widest of all, got set down at the five-sixteenths pole, angled towards the five path spinning into the lane, closed in well down the center of the strip en route for place honors. MORE MISCHIEF pressed the winner from the two path, was slightly wider challenging in earnest heading into the stretch, got staved off. THE GREAT JOHANNA took up the chase from the three path, was driven four wide into the lane, proved no match. NO HAYNE NO GAYNE went over to the rail after making light contact with the second place finisher, got roused leaving the three-eighths pole, spun approximately four wide into the lane, made no headway, then after being placed to a protective hold, was allowed to fade away from midlane onward. ENGLISH SOUL remained stationed along the inside route after the field had been sent off and running, went about the first half mile, appearing keen and pulling on the left, bore out badly during the run around the bend, dropping way back, got pulled up after being eased coming into the lane, walked off the track.
