**Footnotes**

LITTLE MIKE three wide around both turns, was patiently handled all the way to the end of the backstretch, advanced in unison with KING KREESA departing it, overhauled the spent former pacesetter near the midway point, edged away with the advantage to lead the field into the stretch and was set down, had a pair of rivals in hot pursuit a furlong down the road, dug in gamely to fend off the runner up. BIG BLUE KITTEN loped along the hedge until nearing the quarter pole, slipped into the two path prior to that station, had his rally stalled a bit while brushing with IMAGINING heading for home, launched a rally after squeezing his way by that opponent, closed in with good energy but got denied by a resolute foe. REAL SOLUTION brushed with TWILIGHT ECLIPSE as the field was sent on its way, sat well reserved from off the inside during the initial stages, began to tip outward upon reaching the second bend, swung four wide into the stretch, kicked into stride after settling in and gained enough real estate on the top one to loom a bold threat with a furlong remaining, fought with vigor to the end but had to settle for the show. SLUMBER (GB) reserved while mostly two wide to the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to earn the last major check. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE made light contact with REAL SOLUTION at the start, was unhurried in midpack from along the outside, lacked the needed stretch response. IMAGINING contently stalked the front runners being two wide, had drifted into the three path heading for the top of the lane, brushed several times with the runner up as that opponent was attempting to be angled outward, failed to fire when asked. KING KREESA strung out three wide on the opening bend, was allowed to drift inward for a better look at the leader midway down the backstretch, ranged up, together with the winner one path farther to the outside after entering the far turn, backed away after reaching the stretch, fell back even more so when allowed to complete the final furlong under his own power. NUTELLO saved ground until the half mile pole and was outrun. JOES BLAZING AARON showed the way from the inside before getting overwhelmed at the three-eighths pole, retreated then got eased.
