EPIC HONOR was content to trail early, was sent up between foes nearing the second turn, lacked room, had to take up repeatedly, angled sharply inside, rallied by a tiring leader and drew off as much the best. BRAVE GUN set a crisp pace for six furlongs, entered the lane with a healthy lead but weakened considerable in the final furlong. SIXOUTASIX was rated early, rallied when put to a drive on the far turn but lacked the needed late bid. SOUTH CITY stalked the pace inside but tired after six furlongs. HIGH NOON MEETING did not threaten. CARTEL pressed the pace for a half and weakened. ABSOLUTE HARMONY pressed the pace to the second turn, stopped and was eased but walked off. VOICE OF DESTINY did not reach contention, was eased in the stretch but walked off.
